EXCHANGE DEED

WHEREAS, the United States of America, by and through the Secretary of the Interior, under authority of Sections 302 and 304 of the Act of June 15, 1935 (49 Stat. 381), entered into an agreement for the exchange of land with Marcus J. Haines and Edna G. Haines, his wife;

NOW, THEREFORE, THIS DEED, by and between the United States of America, by and through the Assistant Secretary of the Interior, party of the first part, and Marcus J. Haines and Edna G. Haines of Princeton, Oregon, parties of the second part;

WITNESSETH, that the party of the first part, for and in consideration of the conveyance to it by the parties of the second part of land situate in Harney County, Oregon, and more particularly described within a deed dated May 8, 1947, and recorded in Deed Book 46, Page 83, county and state aforesaid, which land is deemed of equal value with the land herein conveyed, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does by these presents convey and grant unto the parties of the second part, their heirs and assigns forever, the following described land in Harney County, Oregon:

Township Twenty-six (26) South, Range Thirty-one (31) East, Willamette Meridian (South of Malheur Lake); in Section thirty-four (34), Lot four (4), and in Section thirty-five (35), Lots one (1) and eight (8), containing 121.75 acres, be the same more or less.

All uranium, thorium, and all other materials determined pursuant to section 5 (b) (1) of the Atomic Energy Act of 1946 (60 Stat. 761) to be peculiarly essential to the production of fissionable material, contained, in whatever concentration, in deposits in the lands covered by this instrument are hereby reserved for the use of the United States, together with the right of the United States through its authorized agents or representatives at any time to enter upon the land and prospect for, mine, and remove the same, making just compensation for any damage or injury occasioned thereby. However, such land may be used, and any rights otherwise acquired by this disposition may be exercised, as if no reservation of such materials had been made; except that, when such use results in the extraction of any such material from the land in quantities which may not be transferred or delivered without a license under the Atomic Energy Act of 1946, as it now exists or may hereafter be amended, such material shall be the property of the United States Atomic Energy Commission, and the Commission may require delivery of such material to it by any possessor thereof after such material has been separated as such from the ores in which it was contained. If the Commission requires the delivery of such material to it, it shall pay to the person mining or extracting the same, or to such other person as the Commission determines to be entitled thereto, such sums, including profits, as the Commission deems fair and reasonable for the discovery, mining, development, production, extraction, and other services performed with respect to such material prior to such delivery, but such payment shall not include any amount on account of the value of such material before

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removal from its place of deposit in nature. If the Commission does not require delivery of such material to it, the reservation hereby made shall be of no further force or effect.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, the same together with all the rights and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining to the said parties of the second part, their heirs and assigns forever, subject, however, to existing public roads and public utility easements.
